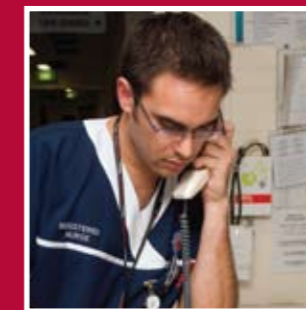
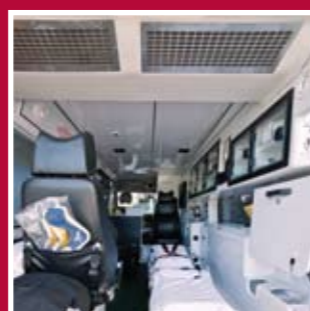

The framework for our Graduate Program centres on opportunities for:

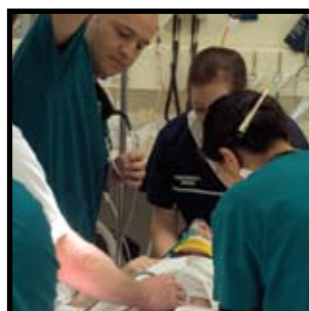
- Nursing experience

## SCGH GRADUATE PROGRAM

The SCGH registered nurse graduate program begins with a minimum of 12 months. Rotations are aimed to provide surgical and medical experiences - with extra rotations to streamline experience into specialty areas on request that you negotiate with the Graduate Coordinators.

Our 12 month program also offers limited rotations to our partnership sites that include **King Edward Memorial, Osborne Park and Silver Chain**. We also offer a 12-month Theatre specific program that offers a comprehensive experience for those wishing to seek a career in peri-operative nursing.

A comprehensive 18-month program is also offered to consolidate medical, surgical and mental health nursing knowledge & clinical skills. This program offers all the benefits of the 12-month program with an additional six-month clinical rotation at **Graylands Campus**, the major mental health facility in Western Australia.
